## The Uninviting

A video installation and photography series by Hallie Jones and Aron Conaway

Opened 6/29/07 as part of the 4th annual Louisville Photo Biennial

'The Uninviting' is a video installation and photography series that explores postindustrial, abandoned and blighted urban landscapes, juxtaposed by the human ability to live in the moment and enjoy life's simple pleasures.

These moving and static images capture coldly volatile and uninviting factories, razorwire fences and dumping grounds. Human subjects fade in and out in front of these alienating "placeless" landscapes, as they playfully illuminate the scene while engaged in activities such as eating an ice cream cone, blowing up balloons, and laughingly exposing a carefree spirit.

The merging of these two seemingly disconnected worlds strikes a contrast between disturbing and joyful. Can the viewer derive meaning based on past personal experiences shared with the subject and the landscapes? Is it possible to harmonize these worlds, and if so, why should we?
